Island Hopping

"A tour through the atoll", the journey starts from Soneva Gili and includes stops at Huraa, Himmafushi and other resorts in the North Male Atoll. Enjoy a snorkeling stop before returning to Soneva Gili.

Visit the Fishing Village of "Huraa"

Huraa is a tiny island located 20 minutes north of Soneva Gili. The island has about 700 inhabitants and you can catch a glimpse of daily life as a fisherman. Huraa is well known for its exquisite carpentry products and gift shops. Huraa is famous for its tiny lake in the center of the island.

Historical Sightseeing in Malé

Eighty five per person Minimum 4 persons 2pm – 6pm

The Islamic Center

(Masjid-al-Sultan Mohamed Thakurufaanu-al-A"z"am)

Malé's most famous architectural landmark is the three-storey Islamic Centre which was constructed in 1984. The shining golden dome of the mosque stands out on the city's silhouette. The interior walls are richly decorated with beautiful woodcarvings and Arabic calligraphy.

Hukuru Miskiiy (Friday Mosque) The Hukuru Miskiiy was built in 1656. The interior and exterior walls of this historic mosque, built with coral stones, are intricately carved with Arabic writings and ornamental patterns.

Munnaru (Minaret) Close to the Friday Mosque is this gleaming white minaret built in 1675. The chief muezzin of Malé called the faithful to prayer from this minaret before the Islamic Centre was built.

Medhu Ziyaarath (The shrine of Abu al Barakaath Yusuf al Barbari)

Abu al Barakaath Yusuf al Barbari is believed to have been responsible for converting the Maldives to Islam way back in 1153.

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Mulee-aage (The former Presidential Palace) The Palace was originally built by Sultan Samsuddeen III for his son just before World War I.

Sultan Park and the National Museum The Sultan's Palace was demolished except for a three-story building and the palace grounds were turned in to a public park, known as the "Sultan Park". The remaining palace building within the park is today the "National Museum". See the "long ear" sculptures from the "sun worshippers" who visited Maldives many thousands of years ago

Tomb of Mohamed Thakurufaanu This tomb is erected in the compound of the "Bihuroazu Kamanaa Mosque", in memory of Sultan Ghazee Mohamed Thakurufaanu, regarded as the greatest of national heroes. He liberated the country from Portuguese rule, who had been occupying the land for 15 years after defeating Sultan Ali VI in 1558.

Jumhooree Maidan Male's most popular place for gatherings and relaxation. It is also one of the favourite evening hang outs for children. On the eastern end of the square stands the official flag post on which is hosted a permanent flag, the largest in the country.

Local fish market Local fisherman display their daily catches. Skipjacks, the main export of the Maldives is both dried and frozen.

Manta Snorkelling

Price varies depend on the location, Minimum 4 persons 10am - 1pm
